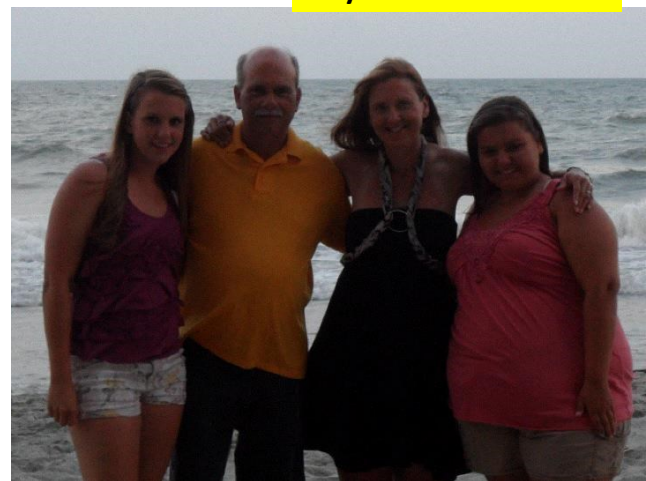
Favorite Conference Adventure Memory: My favorite memory is from IRHOC 2014 at Indiana University-Bloomington when I received IRHO Student of the Year.
